Topics of the conference - day two

- Measuring local needs (h. 9.30-11.00)
 Health governance is strongly regionalised, "local" in its demand and supply characteristics: investment performance, local sanitary demand and political fragmentation among regions make the governance of the health system difficult and not always coherent
- Information and competition (h. 11.15-12.45)
 Individuals play a key role in the health system: both on the demand side by choosing information and access to health and on the supply side by determining the performance of hospitals
